

AUCTION 28 ended with a flurry of bids resulting in some surprising prices on many of the lots. We reduced bidding in this sale on 44% of the lots, a greater percentage of bid reductions than ever before in one of our sales. Since the sale closed, we have talked with many of you who were disappointed that your bids were not successful. One explanation is that we were conservative with our estimates, concerned about the economic uncertainty still out there even though the stock market has rallied from its April low. The other explanation is that there were some exceptional coins in this sale. We had more bids from dealers than we usually have and you can expect to see some of the lots being offered again in someone else's inventory. *All the invoices have been sent out. If you have not received an invoice from us, you were not successful (but now you have a second chance!)*

Lots that did not sell are offered here at prices reflecting the quality and value of the coins. This sale offered a larger group of better quality ancient coins than we have been able to muster over the past few auctions and many highly desirable coins are left. You may order by email, telephone, fax or by simply writing to us. For the sake of simplicity, assume \$12 shipping for any US address order. We will send your choices by Priority Mail, insured. Larger orders to US addresses will be sent by Express Mail. Non US addresses, \$20 flat fee. N.B. January 4-9 we will be at the New York International Coin Fair.
